Warren School Uniform Guidelines

Boys and Girls will be required to wear:

- Plain white, gray or maroon button-down shirt with collar or polostyle shirt (no logos).
- Plain navy or khaki uniform pants: hemmed or cuffed and fitted at the waist. No jeans (skinny jeans), athletic pants, or baggy pants. Plain navy or khaki uniform shorts, longer than the length of fingertips at side to just above the knee.
- Girls also have the option of wearing a plain navy or khaki jumper or skirt.
- On Fridays, students will be allowed to wear any university t-shirt or uniform top with uniform bottoms.
- Types of shoes are up to the family (no open toed shoes) for safety reasons).
