## NOVEMBER 12 –HYBRID MODEL STARTING

The TUSD Board has approved for schools to start a Hybrid Learning Model- Thursday, November 12.

### Daily Schedule – in school

- 7:30-7:45 Drop off / Breakfast  
No playground  
Students need to bring their own water bottle, no drinking fountains  
Masks required  
max 14 students per classroom  
all teachers will be on campus  
Students can bring backpacks with all of their own personal supplies. If they do not have something we will supply the item if possible. These items will not be returned.
- 7:45-10:55 School in person lessons- No Computer  
15 minute break/PE/recess during the morning (all classes at different times)
- 10:55 Dismissal -  
hand out lunches to take home  
Please do not crowd from door, social distance, no entry into school building  
Students will be coming out different exits based upon class location

11:30-1:55 In the afternoon, students will have art and counseling lessons via the computer.  
No teacher interaction except for art, counseling, special services  
Please have students log on to computer after lunch by 11:30 to do their work.  
Teachers will be giving students assignments to work on by themselves.

### Remote Schedules – at Home Learning

7:45-10:55 Students will meet for art or counseling lessons via the computer  
Students will be working on assignments via the computer **without** teacher interaction  
Teachers will provide guidance on what the students will be working on.

11:30-1:55 Students will log on to zoom to meet with their teacher to have their lessons

### Wednesdays- zoom

7:45-11:00 All students will be on zoom with their teachers for lessons

11:30-1:00 Asynchronous learning, information coming from their teacher

## VIRTUAL LEARNING AT HOME

As we continue this virtual journey together, we would like to put out a few reminders to families. Students need a quiet area for themselves to study and work. Using science fair boards could help separate children in the house. Headphones could be a lifesaver for some students. If you need supplies, please let us know. The following are things to think about when helping your student succeed at home.

- **Log on early-** School starts at 7:45 am, have students start logging on by 7:40 am
- **Regular School Day-** 7:45-1:55 pm or 12:55 on Wednesdays, try and make this day as normal as possible, *including uniform top*
- **Eating during class-** eat snacks during breaks and lunch
- **Appropriate background-** please check the background of the students and make sure it is appropriate
- **Distractions-** Try to keep all distractions to a minimum while live zoom meetings are happening
- **Language-** During live zooms, the language in the background needs to be school appropriate

## WACS K-3 NOVEMBER 23

Starting November 23<sup>rd</sup>, Kinder through 3<sup>rd</sup> grade will be taking the WACS exam. Students will be taking the tests via the computer.

## BENCHMARK 2<sup>ND</sup> QT TESTING – NOVEMBER 30 GRADES 2-5

Benchmark testing for grades 2-5 will start November 30<sup>th</sup> and continue through December. Students will be tested in Writing, Reading, and Math. More information will come from the teachers.
