NO SCHOOL MARCH 12, 2021

MARCH 22 AND 23RD

Monday, March 22 is the beginning of the 4th quarter and normal remote teaching will happen that day. Teachers will be giving out assignments to complete on Tuesday, March 23. There will not be any interaction with teachers that day as it will be used to get ready for the students to return to the classroom.

WEDNESDAY MARCH 24 – IN PERSON LEARNING STARTS

On Wednesday, March 24th in person learning will start for those families who choose to come into the building. If your student will be on campus, they will need the following:

1. Laptop
2. All textbooks; math, ELA,
3. Supplies that you have
4. **Water bottle with name on it**
5. **Mask**
6. Complete uniform

Once all families have made their decision to either come to school or remain remote, there may be a teacher change. More information will come the week of March 8th.

VIRTUAL LEARNING AT HOME

As we continue this virtual journey together, we would like to put out a few reminders to families. Students need a quiet area for themselves to study and work. Using science fair boards could help separate children in the house. Headphones could be a lifesaver for some students. If you need supplies, please let us know. The following are things to think about when helping your student succeed at home.

- **Log on early**- School starts at 7:45 am, have students start logging on by 7:40 am
- **Regular School Day**- 7:45-1:55 pm or 12:55 on Wednesdays, try and make this day as normal as possible, *including uniform top*
- **Eating during class**- eat snacks during breaks and lunch.
- **Appropriate background**- please check the background of the students and make sure it is appropriate.
- **Distractions**- Try to keep all distractions to a minimum while live zoom meetings are happening.
- **Language**- During live zooms, the language in the background needs to be school appropriate.
