- They will make more thoughtful, positive choices.
- They will take pride in their achievements.
- They will feel more belonging with their peers at school.

Here are some lifetime skills that your child will develop:

- They will associate the positive things they do with who they are as a person.
- They will exert control over their life and their outcomes.

Here are some questions you can ask your child about using PAX Leader:

- How were you a PAX Leader today? How did that make you feel?
- Who else did you notice being a PAX Leader today? What did they do?
- What PAX Leaders do we know in our family and friends?
