Building Parental Capacity

To build a strong partnership we offer six ways for families to be involved.

1. Parenting

We will provide workshops on self-esteem, expressions/communication, parenting, computer, nutrition/exercise, and how to help your child with homework. Workshops and meetings will be held during the morning, afternoon, and evenings. A survey will be sent out to see what time is most convenient for you.

2. Communication

Families will be asked to communicate with the school, by emails, notes, and by stopping in once per month to check on their child's academic progress. We will make information

available in a variety of formats (newsletters, flyers, news bulletins, school website, social media, and phone calls if necessary). Program activities, parental involvement opportunities, and meeting information are provided on nondiscriminatory basis. Whenever it is possible we will translate communication to other languages so that parents will understand the school expectations outlined in the parent/school/student compact.

3. Volunteering

Families will have the opportunity to serve on and off campus. A volunteer orientation will be provided. Parents may help students by:

- Attending student performances
- Participating in the Booster club or teacher organization (PTO)
- Being a member of the school Site Council
- Helping raise tax credit money
- Seeking donations that will provide incentives for improving student attendance or reading goals
- Creating a school culture that promotes parental involvement
- Sharing other areas of expertise
- Working in the classroom
- Listening to children read, helping with math or other academic areas
- Help in the Library

4. Learning at Home

Families will be provided information about school programs and may request workshops about specific programs or specific areas of information such as, computers, district parental access page, Arizona State Standards or other topics of interest.

5. Decision Making

Families will have the opportunity to help the school make decisions through the school Site Council, Booster Club, and participation in the annual Title I budget meeting.

6. Collaborating with the Community

Families will be provided information about services, the Wakefield Family Center, additional resources, and activities in the community including summer programs for students.
